

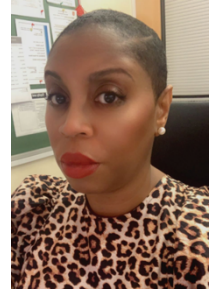

Year 4 – Margaret and Amelia

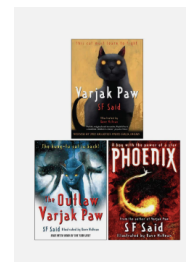
Year 5 – Mohib and Salma
