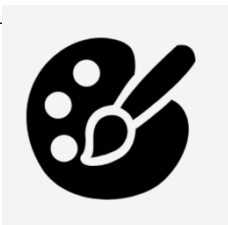
It is World Religions Day on Monday 19th January.

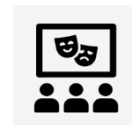
