If unsuitable for children, write 'adults only'.	3 Fill with kind and useful gifts Please DO NOT include: • Second hand clothing • Items containing alcohol • Non vegetarian sweets • Food that needs preparation (such as rice or pasta). • Instant coffee and teabags are fine.
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Things you can include:

A "wow" item like a stuffed animal, smaller toys (such as cars, blocks, or puzzles), school supplies (like notebooks, crayons, and pencils), personal care items (such as a toothbrush and soap), and accessories (like socks, a hat, or gloves).
