attend.



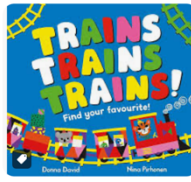
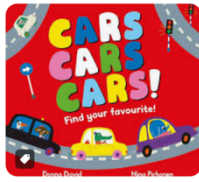
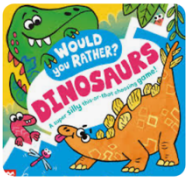
**Whole School Spring Concert will be on Tuesday
