SATs Week: Week beginning: Monday 11th May 2026

 English	This half term Y6 will be focusing on Poetry and Narrative. Our Shared Reading text will be 'Letters from the Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll. Suggested authors which the children have particularly enjoyed are Malorie Blackman and S F Said. Have a read of some of their books! https://openlibrary.org/ This is a free online library where you can access a range of books.
 Maths	During this half term, children will be focusing on Geometry, This will involve working with shape, position and direction. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/subjects/z826n39
 Science	In Science, this half term, children will be learning about variation and adaptation. This will include animal and plant adaptations as well as inheritance and characteristics.
 RE	During RE, children shall look at More Hindu Stories with a particular focus on what Hindu's learn from Vishnu's stories and symbols.
 Computing	In Computing, children will be studying Data and Information - introduction to spreadsheets.
 Geography	In Geography, the children will be learning about Earthquakes with a particular focus on the effects of earthquakes on people and on the environment.
History	During this half term the children will be learning about Arabia and early Islam and with a focus on the kind of changes Prophet Muhammad brought about in Arabia.
 Art and Design	Children will be learning about Sculpture & 3D: Making memories.
 PE	In PE, children will be developing their striking and fielding skills Please remember that children are to come into school dressed in their PE kits every Thursday. Children should come dressed in a plain navy blue or black tracksuit and a plain white or blue t-shirt.
 Music	In Music, children will be exploring the music and composers of the Baroque Period and investigating the structural and stylistic features of their work.
Modern Foreign Languages	In Latin children will be learning about the Past Continuous Tense.
PSHE	In PSHE, this half term, children will be focusing on Economic Awareness which will include budgeting, financial terms and consumer sense.
