Part A: Curriculum music

At Christ Church, we use the Kapow to deliver our music curriculum, which is informed by the model music curriculum. Pupils have a 45-minute lesson per week. Key elements of the sessions are captured in a journal and via video clips.

It is an inclusive curriculum and is accessible to all pupils, through scaffolding and adaptation.

Year 4 have whole class instrument lesson. They learn to play the Recorder with 1 to 1 sessions and gradings.

- Children sing in every assembly and there is a musical worship assembly, which focuses on choral singing.

- Link to Birmingham Conservatoire to attend concerts
- Working with professionals on music projects and performances
- Outside musical visitor performances – Stringcredibles/CBSO
- Support from Music Hub – Services for Education
