 English	This half term Y6 will be focusing on Poetry, Fiction and Non-Fiction. Our Shared Reading text will be 'Who Let The Gods Out' by Maz Evans. Our author of the term is William Shakespeare. https://openlibrary.org/ This is a free online library where you can access a range of books.
 Maths	During this half term, children will be focusing on Ratio, Algebra and Decimals as well as revisiting Fractions, Decimals and Percentages.
 Science	In Science this half term, children will be learning about Light and Light Pollution. BBC Bitesize is a great website for your children to do some extra reading. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zxm96rd
 RE	During RE, children shall be starting a unit called 'Rama and Sita.' During this unit, children will be looking at ancient stories and focusing on the story of Rama and Sita and where Hinduism derives from.
 Computing	In Computing, children will be exploring the concept of variables in programming through games in Scratch. Children will find out what variables are and relate them to real-world examples of values that can be set and changed.
 History	During this term, the children will be focusing on 'Roman Britain' during their History lessons. Children will be exploring how Romans invaded Britain along with the Roman town Aquae Sulis and Hadrian's Wall.
 Geography	In Geography, our new unit is called, 'Coastal processes and landforms.' During this unit, we will be learning all about coastlines, including how they are formed and some of the features and processes involved. We shall also be exploring the Jurassic coastline and coastal habitats.
 Art	During Art, we will be focusing on the skill of drawing with a focus on Making our voice heard, through art.
 PE	During this half term, children will study a dance unit during their PE lessons. Please ensure that children come to school with correct PE kit every Thursday.
 Music	In Music, children will be focusing on Film Music.
 Latin	This half term, the children will be learning Latin. They will be learning to use adjectives to describe themselves.
 PSHE	In PSHE this half term, children will begin by focusing on physical illness, immunisation and vaccination, marriage and the safe zone.
