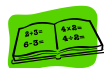


Year 3 Newsletter - Autumn 2 2025

 English	This half term Y3 will be focusing on Fiction and Non-fiction. Our Shared Reading text will be 'The boy who grew dragons' by Andy Shepherd with the theme being Responsibility and Friendship. https://openlibrary.org/ This is a free online library where you can access a range of books.
 Maths	During this half term, children will be focusing on number. This will include addition and subtraction and multiplication. Don't forget to login into TTRS. How fast are you? https://play.ttrockstars.com/auth/school/student https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z2nqfmd
 Science	In Science, this half term, children will be learning about food waste and rocks. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zsqhcx
 RE	During RE, children shall look at the following dispositions: Disposition: Commitment: Remembering roots, Community: Cultivating inclusion, identity and belonging, being curious and valuing knowledge and identity and belonging.
 Computing	In Computing, children will use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation. Next, they will apply those skills to create a story-based animation. This unit will conclude with learners adding other types of media to their animation, such as music and text.
 Geography	In geography, the children will be learning about Mountains.
History	During the half term the children will be learning about Cradles of Civilization.
 Design and Technology	This half term children will be exploring cooking and nutrition: eating seasonally.
 PE	PE is now on a Tuesday. Our unit this half term is Gymnastics: Movement. The children will learn pike jumps, straight jump half-turns, cat leaps, forward rolls from standing, tucked backward rolls, chassis steps and the squat on vault while developing their understanding of the necessary flexibility, strength and control. They will have the opportunity to choreograph their own sequences and routines, performing individually and with a partner.
 Music	In Music, children will be Creating compositions in response to an animation (Theme: Mountains)
Latin	In Latin children will continue learning about the origins of language and present and past tense.
PSHE	In PSHE, this half term, children will be focusing on friendships, loss/separation and online relationships.
