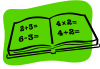


Year 4 Newsletter -Autumn 2 2025

This newsletter outlines all of the learning that your children will be doing during our second half term, we hope that you find it useful.

 English	This half term Y4 will be focusing on a Narrative 'Lord of the Forest' and a non-fiction text 'How to keep a teacher happy?' Our Shared Reading text will be 'The Indian in The Cupboard' by Lynne Reid Banks. Our author of the term is Valarie Bloom. https://openlibrary.org/ This is a free online library where you can access a range of books.
 Maths	During this half term, children will be focusing on area, multiplication, and division. To support the learning of your children, please ensure that children are logging on to TTRS and are practising their timetables.  Science	In Science, this half term, children will be learning about states of matter. We will be investigating melting and evaporation. BBC Bitesize is a great website for your children to do some extra reading on what they will be covering in Science lesson. Year 4 BBC Bitesize
 RE	During RE, children shall look at the following dispositions: Understanding Christianity: Trinity.
 Computing	In Computing, children will be focusing on 'The Internet'. Children will focus on appreciating the internet as a network and will learn that the World Wide Web is part of the internet. They will be given opportunities to explore the World Wide Web for themselves.
 History	. This half term, children will be focusing on The Roman Empire. Children will be learning about the Roman army, the first emperor and how Rome expanded.
 Geography	During this half term, children will be focusing on Population. Children will be learning about what population is, migration and multi-ethnic London.
 Design and Technology	During Design and Technology this term, children will be focusing on Structure: Pavilions. They will investigate model frame structures to improve their stability, and then apply this research to design and create a stable, decorated pavilion.
 PE	During this half term, children will be focusing on gymnastics; it focuses specifically on floor and vault movements. Children will learn turns, cat leaps; half turns and lunges into cartwheels. PE will take place on Wednesday mornings, please ensure that your children come to school in their correct PE kits: navy blue or black joggers/shorts/leggings and a plain white t-shirt, and trainers. If children do not attend with the correct PE kit, the office shall call you and request that the correct clothing be brought into school.
 Music	In Music, children will continue learn how to play the recorder. Children will focus on exploring different rhythms and how to use the recorder. They are also practising a piece for the Christmas concert.
PSHE	In PSHE, this half term, children will be focusing on Health and Well-being. They will be learning about healthy lifestyles, ourselves growing and changing, keeping safe and drugs, alcohol and Tobacco.
