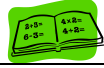


Year 1 Newsletter -Summer 2 2025

Dear parents, this is the Summer 2, newsletter.
We are looking forward to our final term and continuing our learning journey. This newsletter outlines all of the learning that your child will be doing during this half term, we hope that you find it useful.

 English	This half term Y1 will be focusing on poetry our and our narrative 'rumplestiltskin' and our non-fiction text will be 'Tortoise diary'. Our Author focus this term is Grace Nichols and our shared reading text is 'Good Knight sleep tight' by David Melling. https://openlibrary.org/ This is a free online library where you can access a range of books.
 Maths	During this half term, children will be focusing on position and direction, place value, money and time.
 Science	In Science, this half term, children will be learning about growing and cooking and seasonal changes.
 RE	During RE, the children will be using the Birmingham agreed syllabus the children shall look at the following dispositions: Remembering roots, Being hopeful and visionary, being Curious and valuing knowledge,
 Computing	Pupils will develop their understanding of the various aspects of using a computer to create and manipulate text. They will become more familiar with using a keyboard and mouse to enter and remove text.
 Geography	In Geography, children will be focusing on what it is like to live in Shanghai.
 DT	During Design and Technology this term, we will be focusing on cooking and nutrition: fruit and vegetables. They will be learning about different fruits and vegetables and their final product will be fruit bowls.
 PE	During this half term, children will be focusing on Yoga: salute to the sun. PE will take place on Monday afternoons, please ensure that your children come to school in their correct PE kits: navy blue or black joggers/shorts/leggings and a plain white t-shirt, and trainers. If children do not attend with the correct PE kit, the office shall call you and request that the correct clothing are brought into school.
 Music	In Music, children will be covering the topic by the sea: vocal and body sound. In this new unit, the children learn how to use their bodies to make sounds as well as using their voice.
 Phonics	In Phonics, we will be using the scheme 'Sounds Write' the child will read and spell words containing the target sounds. They will develop their knowledge that a sound can be represented by one or more spelling.
 PSHE	In PSHE, this half term, children will be focusing on sun safety, road safety, and money.
