This newsletter outlines all of the learning that your children will be doing during this half term, we hope that you find it useful.

 English	This half term, Y4 will continue to focus on a narrative called 'Trust' and a non-fiction text on 'Teachers.' Our Shared Reading text will be 'Journey to Jo'burg' by Beverly Naidoo. Throughout this text, we will focus on freedom and dignity. Our author of the term is Onjali Q. Rauf. https://openlibrary.org/ This is a free online library where you can access a range of books.
 Maths	During this half term, children will focus on Decimals, Money and Time. To support the learning of your children, please ensure that children are logging onto www.timestable.co.uk and are practising their timetables.
 Science	In Science, this half term, children will be learning about The Digestive System and Food Chains. Children will identify the tooth structure of different animals in relation to their diet and understand why humans have more than one type of tooth. BBC Bitesize is a great website for your children to do some extra reading on what they will be covering in Science lesson. Year 4 BBC Bitesize
 RE	During RE, children shall look at the following dispositions: Responding to suffering, being temperate, self-disciplined and seeking contentment, being imaginative and exploratory and appreciating beauty,
 Computing	In Computing, children will be focusing on Creating Media - Photo editing. Children will develop their understanding of how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can be resaved and reused. They will consider the impact and evaluate the effectiveness of their choices.
 History	This half term, children will be focusing on Alexander the Great.
 Geography	During this half term, children will be focusing on Climate and Biomes.
 Art and Design.	During Art and Design this term, children will be focusing on Craft and Design: Fabric of Nature. Throughout this unit, children will be able to describe objects, images and sounds. They will understand different methods of creating printed fabric in creative industries.
 PE	During this half term, we will focus on Athletics. PE will take place on Wednesday mornings, please ensure that your children come to school in their correct PE kits: navy blue or black joggers/shorts/leggings and a plain white t-shirt, and trainers. If children do not attend with the correct PE kit, the office shall call you and request that the correct clothing be brought into school.
 Music	In Music, children will continue learn how to play Djembe drums with Mr Siani. Children will focus on exploring crotchets and different dynamics.
PSHE	In PSHE, this half term, children will be focusing on Living in the wider world -Media Literacy and Digital Resilience and Economic Wellbeing: Money.
Latin	This half term, children will learn about adverbs. They will know that Latin adverbs tend to end in '-e' or '-ter.'
