This newsletter will outline what your children will be learning across the curriculum this half term.

English 	This half term, Y6 will be focusing on Fiction and Non-Fiction. They will be writing a narrative and biography during this time! Our Shared Reading text will be 'Letters from the Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll. The theme we will be focusing on is 'Safety and Determination'. Maths 	During this half term, the children will be focusing on themed projects, consolidation and problem solving.
Science 	In Science this half term, children will be learning about Fossils. This will include how fossils are formed as well as the famous scientist Mary Anning.
RE 	During RE, the children shall look at the following dispositions: <i>Participating and Willing to Lead, Being Temperate, Self-Disciplined and Seeking Contentment, Being Accountable and living with integrity.</i>
Computing 	In Computing, children will be focusing on Creating Media: 3D Modelling.
History 	During this term, the children will be focusing on History. Our Topic will be the 'Alexander the Great'.
Geography 	In geography, the children will be learning about Climate and Biomes.
Art and Design 	In Design Technology, the children will be focusing on Digital world: Navigating the world. In Art, the children will be Sculpture and 3D: Making memories.
PE 	During this half term, the children will be learning Athletics and Leadership in PE. This will happen every Thursday. Please remember that the children must wear PE kits from home and wear joggers, a white or blue shirt and trainers.
Music 	In Music, the children will be focusing on our Leavers' Song.
Modern Foreign Languages	This half term, the children will be learning Latin. They will be learning subjects and object nouns.
PSHE	In PSHE this half term, the children will be focusing on making Money - generating income and raising money. .
