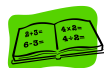


Year 6 Newsletter - Summer 1 2025

Dear parents, welcome to Year 6 and our Summer 1 newsletter.
We have a busy term ahead of us, as the children continue to work hard in preparation for their SATs. This newsletter format will outline what your children will be learning across the curriculum this half term.

English 	This half term Y6 will be focusing on Poetry and Narrative. Our Shared Reading text will be 'Letters from the Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll. Suggested authors which the children have particularly enjoyed are Malorie Blackman and S F Said. Have a read of some of their books! https://openlibrary.org/ This is a free online library where you can access a range of books.
Maths 	During this half term, children will be focusing on Geometry. This will involve working with shape, position and direction. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/subjects/z826n39
Science 	In Science, this half term, children will be learning about variation and adaptation. This will include animal and plant adaptations as well as inheritance and characteristics.
RE 	During RE, children shall look at the following dispositions: Creating Unity and Harmony, Creating Inclusion, Identity and Belonging, and Responding to Suffering.
Computing 	In Computing, children will be studying Data and Information - introduction to spreadsheets.
Geography 	In Geography, the children will be learning about Volcanoes.
History	During the half term, the children will be learning about the Ancient Greece.
Art and Design 	This half term, children will be learning about Sculpture & 3D: Making memories.
PE 	During this half term, children will be developing their striking and fielding skills Please remember that children are to come into school dressed in their PE kits every Thursday. Children should come dressed in a plain navy blue or black tracksuit and a plain white or blue t-shirt.
Music 	In Music, children will be exploring the music and composers of the Baroque Period and investigating the structural and stylistic features of their work.
Modern Foreign Languages	In Latin children will be learning about verbs and adverbs.
PSHE	In PSHE, this half term, children will be focusing on Economic Awareness which will include budgeting, financial terms and consumer sense.
