

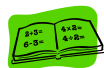
Year 3 Newsletter - Autumn 1 2026

English 	This half term Y3 will be focusing on Poetry and Fiction. Our Shared Reading text will be 'The boy who grew dragons' by Andy Shepherd, with the theme being responsibility and friendship. https://openlibrary.org/ This is a free online library where you can access a range of books.
Maths 	During this half term, children will be focusing on number. This will include place value and addition and subtraction. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z2nqf6m
Science 	In Science, this half term, children will be learning about Biology. This will include skeletons, movement, nutrition and diet.
RE 	During RE, children shall look at and learn about a Hindu story - Rama and Sita.
Computing 	In Computing, children will be exploring Computing systems and networks - connecting computers. They will develop their understanding of digital devices, with an initial focus on inputs, processes, and outputs, also compare digital and non-digital devices.
Geography 	In Geography, the children will be learning about Rivers.
History	During the half term, the children will be learning about Ancient Egypt.
Art and Design 	This half term, in Art and Design, the children will be focusing on drawing learning a range of skills to become a growing artist. The children will also have the opportunity to work with artist in residence.
PE 	During this half term, children will be developing their dancing skills. Please remember that children are to come into school dressed in their PE kits every Wednesday. Children should come dressed in a plain navy blue or black tracksuit and a plain white or blue t-shirt.
Music 	In Music, children will be exploring the theme of ballads and singing in time/tune.
Latin	As we begin a new journey in Latin, we will spend the first half term with an introduction to the language and learning about the origins of languages.
PSHE	In PSHE, this half term, children will be focusing on different themes such as circle time, falling out, self-image and identity.
